Parenting is never easy. When you have a child who is difficult, it becomes even harder. Whether your child is in pre-school, high school, or somewhere in between, you will take away valuable tips from this presentation. Dr. Gibson will speak about the book, the program he created and offer some basic suggestions for turning difficult situations around. Dr. Gibson was recently appointed to the Connecticut Commission on Children.
