Guest Speaker: Dr. Erica Warren

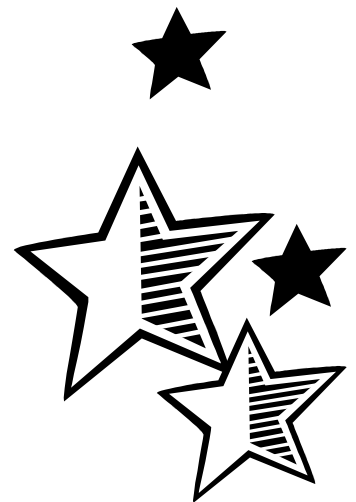
Aspiring to empower the spirit of non-traditional learners, Dr. Warren tailored a special degree program that combined course-work and research in Educational Psychology, Special Education, School Psychology, and Adult Education. Her doctoral degree in Education from the University of Georgia focused on the life-long issues of learning, the impact of learning disabilities across the life span and comprehensive diagnostic assessments. Her diverse training has lead to a well-rounded expertise in the areas of learning and cognition. She has 14 educational publications, has designed college programs for students with learning needs, worked as a learning specialist for private and public institutions, designed study skills courses, conducted educational workshops and courses around the country, counseled with students and families on learning and organizational techniques, designed incentives programs, advised on assistive technology and software tools, taught students with limited to extraordinary capabilities, assisted schools in determining reasonable accommodations, consulted in program design and teacher training, and has written comprehensive learning profiles and diagnostic assessments.

Much of Dr. Warren's attention remains devoted to her students on a one-on-one basis where her unique approach focuses on teaching students how to optimize their potentials through the use of fun, multi-sensory strategies and cognitive techniques. Dr. Warren doesn't ask her students to fit into a program; instead she creates a unique course of instruction for each of her students. Dr. Warren founded her private practice, Learning to Learn in 1999 and her educational resources company, Good Sensory Learning, in 2005.
