ABOUT THE 2012-2013 BUDGET and ABOUT SPECIAL EDUCATION

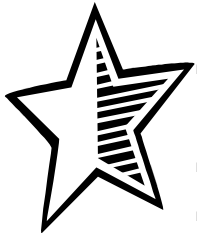
Come to the first SEPTA meeting of the year.
